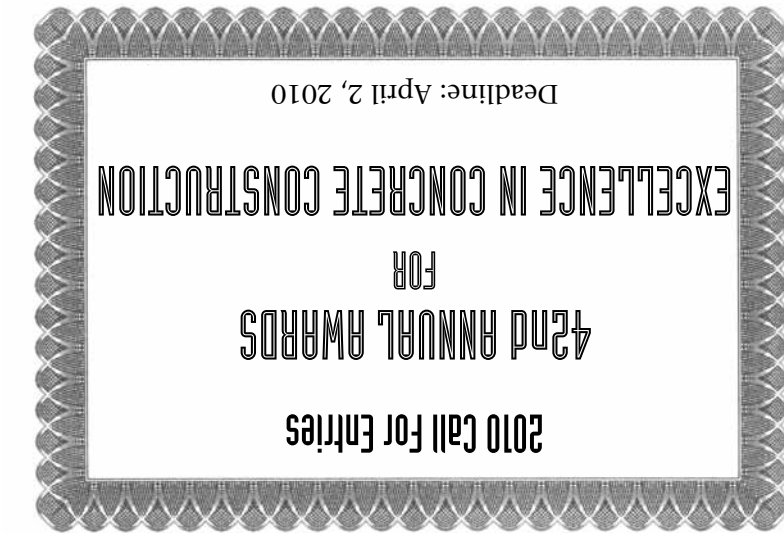

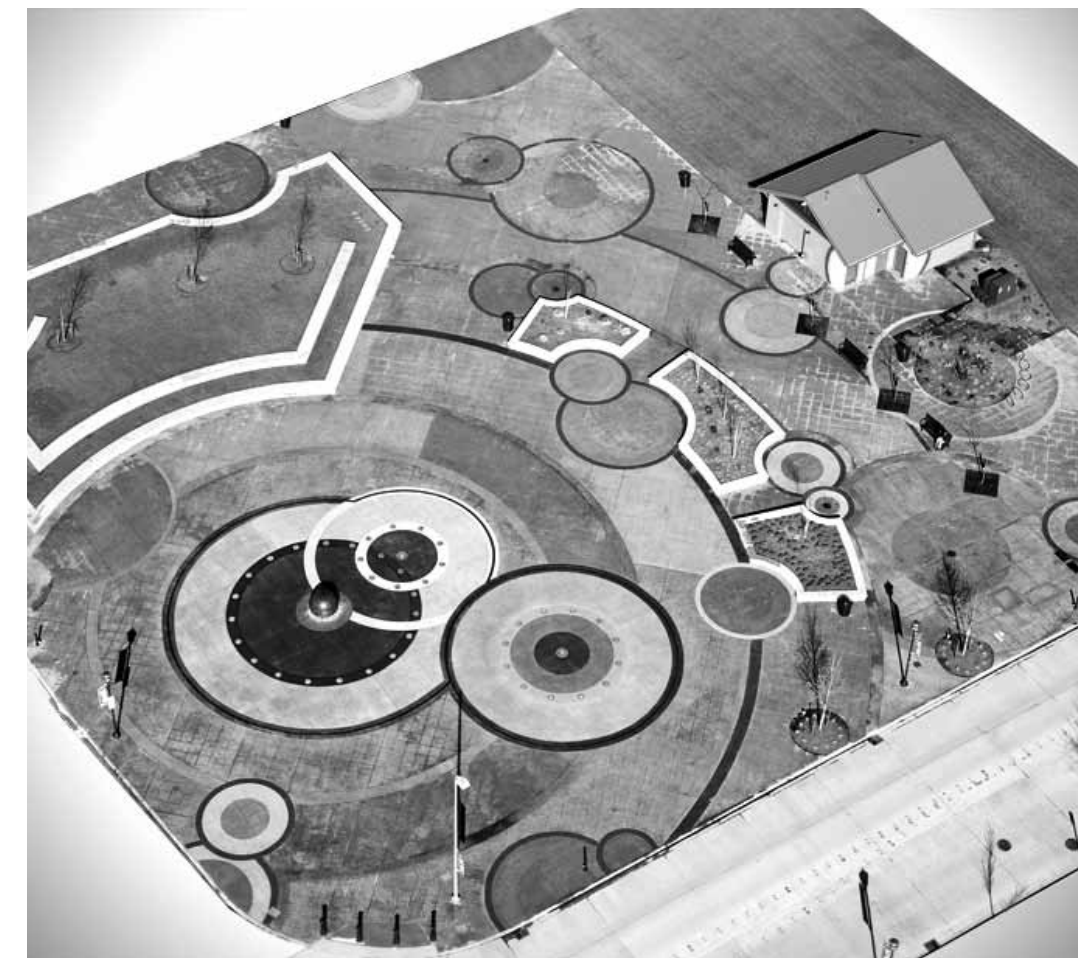

2010 Awards for Excellence in Concrete Construction

The Washington Aggregates and Concrete Association is pleased to formally recognize your professional accomplishments in the outstanding use of Ready Mix Concrete throughout Washington State.

Entries are juried by an independent panel of industry professionals comprised of 2009 award winners. Finalists and a category winner are selected from each of the categories. The Grand Award winner will be awarded to the category winner that best reflects the unique advantages of Ready Mix Concrete. In recognition of their contributions, our Concrete Awards will be presented to the Owner, Architect, Contractor, Structural Engineer, Concrete Contractor and Ready Mix Supplier.

SUBMITTAL GUIDELINES

- Projects must be located in Washington State.
- Projects are eligible for **2 years after their completion (from January 2008 to December 31, 2009)**.
- Projects must be classified in one of eight categories; Cast in Place Structures, Special Applications, Public Works, Tilt-up, Concrete Paving, Residential, Architectural Concrete or Sustainable Merit.
- Precast elements must comprise 45% or less of total concrete within project, precast only projects are ineligible.
- Submit as many projects as you wish. Each entry should be in a separate binder with its own submittal form.

NEW SUSTAINABLE MERIT CATEGORY NEW

This new category allows projects to be recognized for the significant contribution of ready mix concrete to meet desired Sustainable and or LEED objectives.

- Any project from any category is eligible and may also remain as an entry in their appropriate category.
- Provide a synopsis of sustainable/LEED credits achieved.

Projects entered in the Sustainable Merit category should emphasize the role of concrete to meet overall project sustainable objectives or contributed to **LEED** Points. These include but are not limited to:

- Green roof systems, heat island reductions, solar reflectivity
- Elimination of interior finishes using natural or decorative concrete
- Exposed exterior wall and structure surfaces
- Pervious concrete products for stormwater management
- Thermal mass strategies, engineering solutions to reduce HVAC requirements, radiant heat etc.
- Other "innovative" uses for improved indoor environment, site enhancement, energy efficiency, daylighting, etc.

SUBMITTAL FORMAT

1. Binders, photography, and project descriptions shall be free of Firm names and logos.
2. Entry should be submitted in a single 8.5 x 11 - 3 ring binder.
3. Complete the attached submittal form on the next page.
4. A one page summary of project describing the advantages of using ready mixed concrete, such as durability, sustainability, economy, constructability, lifecycle benefits, project aesthetics, compatibility with project environment, etc. This must be written on plain, letterhead free 8.5 x 11 stationary with project name only.(10 DPI min.)
5. Quality photography required. Select photographs that best represent your project in both finished and/or during construction phases.
 - One (1) set of seven (7) digital photos (JPEG Format 640X480 or larger resolution). A hard print of all disk photography (8x10) required in submittal binder. For best results use quality photo paper. (No zip discs).
 - OR
 - One (1) set of seven (7) color slides and a set of two (2) 8 x 10 color photographs.
6. All binders and photography shall be retained by the Washington Aggregates and Concrete Association for publicity use at our discretion. Entries will not be returned.
7. Finalists will be notified by R.S.V.P. invitation to attend the Awards Presentation Banquet April 29, 2010. The winners in each category will be held confidential until the banquet. All entrants are cordially invited to attend the banquet.
