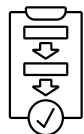

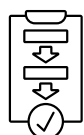

CATEGORY III — CEMENT COMPANIES

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RATE: \$3,750

CATEGORY IV — FLY ASH, SLAG, & ADMIXTURE

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RATE: \$2,500

CATEGORY V — CAPITAL EQUIPMENT RELATED

Companies that distribute, manufacture, sell or service capital equipment including, but not limited to batch plants, aggregate processing, trucks and related components, excavation or manufacturing equipment, environmental/recycling systems, and scales. Includes all batching, conveyor, screening, washing, crushing, and service and related parts for the above systems and equipment. Providers of bulk transportation services are included in this category.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RATE: \$1,500

CATEGORY VI — CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS & CONSULTING

- Non-Capital Equipment: Companies that distribute, manufacture, sell, or service-related accessories including but not limited to specialty additives, fuel & lubricants, and shop supplies.
- Construction Products: Including but not limited to ICF forms, color, pre-cast, fibers, etc.
- Consulting & Professional Services: Including but not limited to geological, land use and permitting, environmental safety, project management, engineering, reclamation, biological SEPA/EIS, insurance, accounting, legal, bonding, appraisals, etc.

CATEGORY VII — CONTRACTORS, FINISHERS & MORE

This category only applies to concrete & aggregate contractors, concrete finishers, concrete & aggregate testing laboratories, and concrete pump companies.
