CATEGORY VI — CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS & CONSULTING

- <u>Non-Capital Equipment:</u> Companies that distribute, manufacture, sell, or service-related accessories including but not limited to specialty additives, fuel & lubricants, and shop supplies.
- <u>Construction Products:</u> Including but not limited to ICF forms, color, pre-cast, fibers, etc.
- <u>Consulting & Professional Services:</u> Including but not limited to geological, land use and permitting, environmental safety, project management, engineering, reclamation, biological SEPA/EIS, insurance, accounting, legal, bonding, appraisals, etc.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RATE: \$950

CATEGORY VII — CONTRACTORS, FINISHERS & MORE

This category only applies to concrete & aggregate contractors, concrete finishers, concrete & aggregate testing laboratories, and concrete pump companies.
